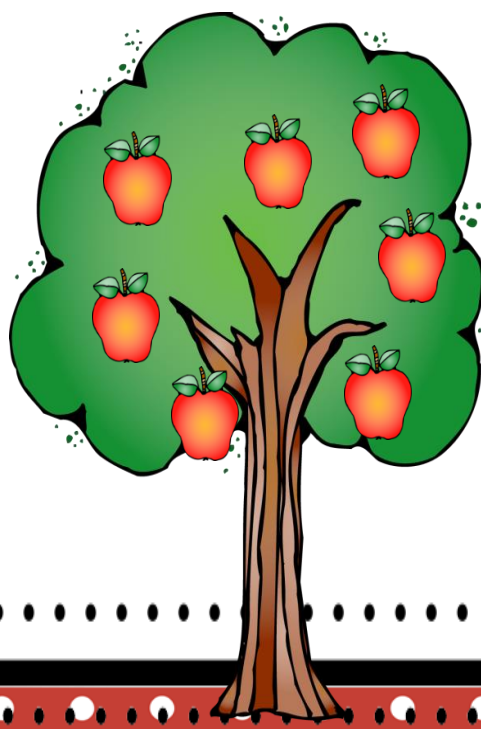


Apple Tree

I use exit tickets at the end of my lessons. It's a great way to let students apply the concept we worked on in the lesson. They are great way to check for understanding.

There are 2 tickets on a page. Just print out what you need and cut the page in half. I have included a copy with colored clipart and a copy that is black and white only.

I give students 3-5 minutes at the end of class to work on them. I only print out one class set (30) and then I put them in half sheet protectors. Students use dry erase markers to write in their answers. When they are done I will take a picture of their work. I have my students erase their answers after I have taken a picture of it.

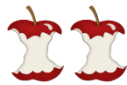

When I grade these I am just looking at the first line. It's the only one that is different than the other three phrases.

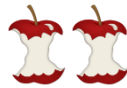
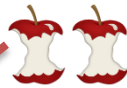

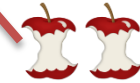
